



2021 Blooming Abroad End of Year Update

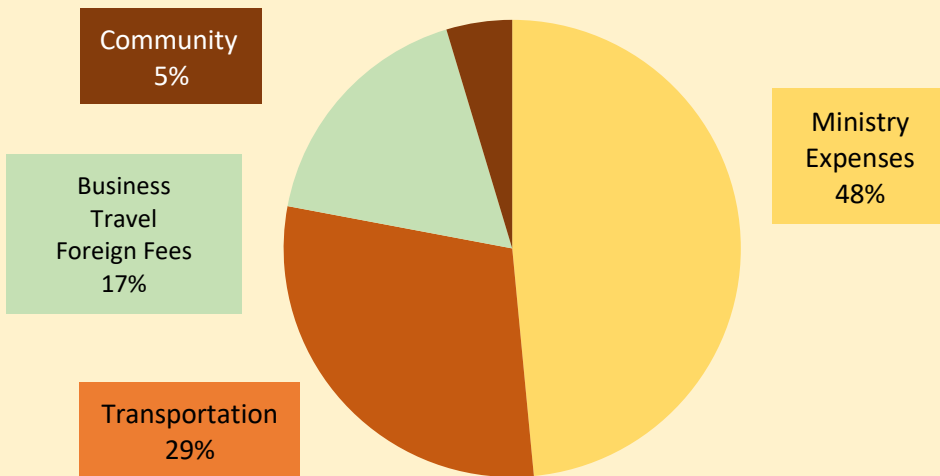
Hello to all our wonderful family, friends and supporters!
